### **Description of Employer:**

Quinte Youth for Christ is a not-for-profit, faith based, charity that serves approx. 1000 youth throughout the Quinte area with spiritual direction & support. Currently Quinte YFC has 7 staff and various temporary and volunteer staff with a ministry focus on relational evangelism, strong leadership, and Kingdom thinking. Our vision is to give every young person the opportunity to make an informed decision to become a follower of Jesus Christ and to be welcomed into a local church.

### **Job Summary:**

This temporary position for students who are interested in Christian ministry employment, who have a good understanding of ministry, faith in God, leadership and working in teams. The position as 'Performing Arts Assistant' encompasses diverse duties depending on what is needed from the director of the performing arts ministry programs for the summer. Specific responsibilities are outlined below.

### **Job Responsibilities:**

  - Preparing a reception for parents

- Prayer & Reflection: Time for personal spiritual growth, coaching regarding skills and abilities.
- Administration: Planning, writing, supervision and evaluation meetings, correspondence and follow up, weekly logs and report, fundraising, etc

- Demonstrate a passion for relational evangelism, knowledge of the Bible and a heart for youth to know Christ
- Track record in leadership, specifically the ability to be self-directed and the ability to lead a team
