Summer Job Position available for Quinte YFC /Youth Unlimited in Prince Edward County. Approximate starting date is July 4th, ending August 29th at student minimum wage for 40 hours per week.

Description of Employer:

Quinte Youth for Christ is a not-for-profit, faith based, charity that serves approx. 1000 youth throughout the Quinte area with spiritual direction & support. Currently Quinte YFC has 7 staff and various temporary and volunteer staff with a ministry focus on relational evangelism, strong leadership, and Kingdom thinking. Our vision is to give every young person the opportunity to make an informed decision to become a follower of Jesus Christ and to be welcomed into a local church.

Job Summary:

This temporary position for students who are interested in Christian ministry employment, who have a good understanding of ministry, faith in God, leadership and working in teams. The position as 'Youth Program Coordinator' encompasses diverse duties depending on what is needed from the local Prince Edward County director of the ministry programs for the summer. Specific responsibilities are outlined below.

Job Responsibilities:

- Assist in running summer outreach program for children in Prince Edward County that includes:
 - Beach ministry to engage beach goers for meaningful conversation with them
 - Summer weekend camping trip for teens
 - Fundraising activities for the summer ministry
 - Identify youth growth with 5 Gauges model
 - Host a forum for ministry leaders to discuss support for youth in the County
- Student Ministry: identify youth, make connections, create intentional relationships
- Goals and planning: Assist in ministry plans for the fall
- Prayer & Reflection: Time for personal spiritual growth, coaching regarding skills and abilities, develop conversational skills
- Administration: Planning, writing, supervision and evaluation meetings, correspondence and follow up, weekly logs and report, fundraising, etc

Candidate must possess:

- Exhibit good organizational, planning, people and communication skills
- Demonstrate a passion for relational evangelism, knowledge of the Bible and a heart for youth to know Christ
- Track record in leadership, specifically the ability to be self-directed and the ability to lead a team
- Show good character traits such as boldness, honesty, integrity, faithfulness, adaptability and joy
- Must be a current student returning to school in the fall of 2016
